About the Eddy County Zoning Commission

What does the Eddy County Zoning Commission Do?

The Planning and Zoning Commission is a seven-member advisory board to the Eddy County Commission. The Zoning Commission membership is comprised of two ex-officio members, being a County Commissioner and a representative of the governing body of the City of New Rockford (currently the Mayor), and five other residents of Eddy County at large. Resident members are appointed by the Eddy County Commission for staggered four-year terms; ex-officio members serve coterminously with their term in their underlying office. The County Auditor serves as secretary to the Commission and keeps all of the records and accounts of the Commission.

The Commission reviews applications for permits and submits recommendations to the County Commission for approval or denial. The Commission also works to update the Zoning Ordinances to address current issues or pending impacts to the community.

How Often Does the Commission Meet?

The Zoning Commission meets regularly on the second Tuesday of the first month of each quarter (i.e. January, April, July, October) and occasionally meets for special meetings as necessary. Meetings are held in the County Commission Meeting Room in the basement of the Eddy County Courthouse.

Do Members Get Paid?

Commission members are paid \$40.00 to attend each Commission meeting and are compensated for their mileage to and from their residence.
