MARRIAGE LICENSE INFORMATION NDCC 14-03

- Marriage certificate is good for 60 days from the day it is issued.
- Fee for a marriage license is \$65.00.
- Both parties need to be present when obtaining the license.
- If either party is divorced, a CERTIFIED COPY of the most <u>recent</u> Divorce Decree must be submitted with the marriage license application. Certified copies of Divorce Decree's can be obtained from the Clerk of Court in the county in which you were divorced.
- Driver's License or some other valid photo ID verifying date of birth is required.
- License can be issued and used in any county in North Dakota; license must be returned to the county it was obtained from.
- If the County Recorder officiate ceremonies and couple is getting married on premises during business hour, the ceremony fee is \$30.00.
- If the County Recorder is performing the ceremony off premises after hours, the Recorder will set the fee.
- To schedule the County Recorder to Officiate please contact the office at 701-947-2434 ext 2013.

You must be at least 18 years old to marry without parental consent. If a person is between 16 and 18 years of age, a parental consent is required. A license MAY NOT be issued to any person below the age of 16.
